The Initial Level was defined as the simple average, based on the Closing Levels of the Reference Asset on the first 10 Business Days to occur on and immediately following the Trade Date.

The final of the 10 Business Days occurred on March 3, 2016. The simple average, based on the Closing Levels of the Reference Asset on the first 10 Business Days to occur on and immediately following the Trade Date, is 1,134.86.

Therefore, the Initial Level for the notes is 1,134.86.
