On December 18, 2013, iGo, Inc. (the "Company") issued a press release advising that it had filed a notice of termination of registration on Form 15 with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission to deregister its common stock, par value \$0.10 per share, with associated Series G Junior Participating Preferred Stock Purchase Rights, under Section 12(g) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the "Act"), and to suspend the Company's periodic reporting obligations under Section 13(a) of the Act. At the time of filing the Form 15, the Company had approximately 270 holders of record as determined pursuant to Rule 12g5-1 promulgated under the Act.
