On December 7, 2018, Lexaria announced that pursuant to existing stock option plans, it has granted stock options to a new employee that enable the option holders to purchase up to 240,000 stock options with an exercise price of US\$1.06, that will vest as to 80,000 per year until April 15, 2021.

Lexaria also announced it has received US\$110,000 from the exercise of warrants previously granted. The Company has received for exercise a total of 250,000 warrants with an exercise price of US\$0.44, previously granted. The warrant exercises are by third parties who are neither an officer nor a director of the Company.

No commissions or placement fees have been paid related to the funds received from these warrants exercised. Proceeds will be used for general corporate purposes.

The securities referred to herein will not be or have not been registered under the United States Securities Act of 1933, as amended, and may not be offered or sold in the United States absent registration or an applicable exemption from registration requirements.
