Smith Combined Incentive Compensation Plan, a transaction exempt under Rule 16b-3: 1,050 restricted stock units were granted on 02/08/2010; 800 restricted stock units were granted on 02/07/2011; and 800 restricted stock units were granted on 02/13/2012. The restricted stock units become payable in Common Stock on the vesting date, which is three years after the grant date.
- (2) Employee stock options were granted under the A. O. Smith Combined Incentive Compensation Plan, a transaction exempt under Rule 16b-3: 2,850 employee stock options were granted on 02/08/2010 and became exercisable in three annual installments of 1/3 of the award starting on 02/08/2011; 2,000 employee stock options were granted on 02/07/2011 and became exercisable in three annual installments of 1/3 of the award starting on 02/07/2012; 2,400 employee stock options were granted on 02/13/2012 and became exercisable in three annual installments of 1/3 of the award starting on 02/13/2013.
